

RESOLUTION NO. R-252213

WHEREAS, the San Diego Youth Involvement Project (SIP), a City operated program funded through Revenue Sharing, is a short-term residential center for juveniles aged 16-21 needing assistance due to truancy, troubled or runaway behavior; and

WHEREAS, SIP offers individual, group and family counseling to youth who are temporarily housed at SIP because of problems at home, in school, or with the law; and

WHEREAS, transportation is an important component of the project in that it is necessary for recreational activities as well as transporting residents to and from juvenile court; and

WHEREAS, SIP's three year lease agreement with Airport Military Rent-a-Car for a van is not renewable due to sale of the leasing company; and

WHEREAS, SIP does not have sufficient funds to purchase the van despite a fine sale offer by Airport Military; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Federal Savings and Loan, having become aware of the SIP program and plight, has generously offered to purchase that van from Airport Military and donate it to the SIP program; NOW, THEREFORE,


