

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. RA-252510 (R.81-322)

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PRO- AUG 25 1980
VISIONS OF THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941,
DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO
VACATE FERN AVENUE AND PORTIONS OF BEYER BOULEVARD,
AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
that the public interest and convenience of said City require
the vacation of Fern Avenue and portions of Beyer Boulevard,
hereinafter mentioned; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said
Council to order the vacation of Fern Avenue and portions of
Beyer Boulevard, as more particularly shown on Drawing No.
19284-D on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document
No. RA 252510.

The Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said
vacation under the provisions of the "Street Vacation Act of
1941."


The Council hereby fixes 2:00 P.M. September 9, 1980,

Administration Building, Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 "C"
Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for
hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed

That The Daily Transcript, a daily newspaper published
and circulated and of general circulation, in said City of
San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper
in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause
to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice
