

RESOLUTION NO. R-252567Adopted on AUG 26 1990

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller i. hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Robert E. Crist	Fire	\$ 50	Mr. Crist is an Auto Messenger. He suggested that a laundry cage be made for the storage of used Fire Department linen. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Robert J. Boisvert	Police	\$ 50	Mr. Boisvert is a Police Officer. He suggested that only one copy of theft related misdemeanors be sent to the investigation division. This is expected to save \$1,000 annually in copying costs annually. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Carol Harrison	General Services	\$ 40	Ms. Harrison is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that rubber stamps be used to process application forms for exempt vehicle plates, duplicate plates, weight change notices, bills of sale, etc. This is expected to save \$140 annually in processing costs.
Allen P. Stalnaker	Fire	\$ 25	Mr. Stalnaker is an Engineer. He suggested that floor area at the dormitory doors at Fire Station 10 be painted to indicate a hazard in the form of doors opening outward into traffic. This was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Frank White	General Services	\$ 25	Mr. White is a Senior Motive Service Technician. He suggested the use of an air operated vacuum cleaner to remove water from tires. This saves an estimated \$84 annually in labor costs.
