

RESOLUTION NO. R-252611 (R.81-958)

Conditional Use Permit No. 10-607-0 SEP 2 1980

WHEREAS, WILLIAM CISCO, an individual, hereafter referred to as "Permittee," filed an application under Conditional Use Permit No. 10-607-0 to construct and operate a senior citizens housing complex consisting of 15 studio units and a two story building with parking and landscaping on .16 acres in the R-4 Zone. The subject property is located on the south side of Boston Avenue between 29th and 30th Streets, in the Barrio Logan/Harbor 101 Community Plan area, and is more particularly described as Lots 21 and 22, Block 17, Reed and Hubbell's Addition, Map 327; and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 1980, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego made its findings of facts, denied said Conditional Use Permit No. 10-607-0, and filed said decision in the office of the City Clerk on August 6, 1980; and

WHEREAS, on July 31, 1980, pursuant to the provisions of Section 101.0506 of the San Diego Municipal Code, WILLIAM CISCO and PERRY TROUT appealed the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, said appeal was set for public hearing on September 2, 1980, and testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having full considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in considering said appeal is empowered by the provisions of Municipal Code, Section 101.0506 to affirm, reverse or modify, in whole or in part, any

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determination of the Planning Commission, subject to the limitations as are placed upon the Planning Commission by the Municipal Code; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

All of the following facts exist with respect to Conditional Use Permit No. 10-607-0:

1. The proposed use will not adversely affect the neighborhood, General Plan or the adopted community plan, and will not be detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare of persons residing or working in the area.

The Barrio Logan/Harbor 101 Community Plan designates the subject property for exclusively residential use. The request is in conformance with the community plan. The proposed use is similar to other residential uses in the area and should not be detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare of persons residing or working in the area.

2. The proposed use will comply with all the relevant regulations of the Municipal Code.


Section 101.0506 paragraph A14 authorizes the Planning Commission to approve housing for the elderly in any residential or commercial zone, subject to appropriate conditions of approval.

The above findings are supported by the minutes, maps and exhibits, all of which are herein incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appeal of WILLIAM CISCO

and PERRY TROUT is granted, and this Council does hereby grant to WILLIAM CISCO, an individual, Owner and Permittee, Conditional Use Permit No. 10-607-0, in the form and with the terms and conditions as set forth in the permit attached hereto and made a part hereof.

CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 10-607-0  
CITY COUNCIL

This Conditional Use Permit is granted by the City Council of The City of San Diego to WILLIAM CISCO, an individual, Owner, hereafter referred to as "Permittee", for the purposes and under the terms and on the conditions as set out herein, pursuant to the authority contained in Section 101.0506 of the Municipal Code of The City of San Diego.

1. Permission is hereby granted to Permittee to construct and operate elderly housing project located on the south side of Boston Avenue between 29th and 30th Streets described as Lots 21 and 22, Block 17, Reed and Hubbell's Addition, in the R-4 Zone.

2. The elderly housing project shall include, and the term "Project" as used in this Conditional Use Permit shall mean the total of the following facilities:

- a. Fifteen studio apartments in one, two-story structure.
- b. Off-street parking.
- c. Incidental accessory uses as may be determined and approved by the Planning Director.

3. Not less than five off-street parking spaces shall be provided and maintained on the subject property in the approximate location shown on Exhibit "A" dated July 24, 1980, on file in the office of the Planning Department. Parking spaces shall be consistent with Division 8 of the Municipal Code and shall be permanently maintained and not converted for any other use. Areas and driveways shall be surfaced with not less

than two inch A.C. or its equivalent and each parking space shall be marked. Parking spaces and aisles shall conform to Planning Department standards. No charge shall be made at any time for the use of these off-street parking spaces.

4. At least one member of each household shall be 62 years of age or older.

5. The Permittee shall comply with the General Conditions for Conditional Use Permits attached hereto and made a part hereof.

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS

1. Prior to the issuance of any building permits, complete building plans (including signs) shall be submitted to the Planning Director for approval. Plans shall be in substantial conformity with Exhibit A, dated July 24, 1980, on file in the office of the Planning Department. The property shall be developed in accordance with the approved building plans except where regulations of this or other governmental agencies require deviation therefrom. Prior to and subsequent to the completion of the project, no changes, modifications or alterations shall be made unless and until appropriate applications for amendment of this permit shall have been approved and granted.

2. Prior to the issuance of any building permits, a complete landscaping plan, including a permanent watering system, shall be submitted to the Planning Director for approval. Said plans shall be in substantial conformity with Exhibit A, dated July 24, 1980, on file in the office of the Planning Department. Approved planting shall be installed prior to the issuance of an occupancy permit on any building. Such planting shall not be modified or altered unless and until this permit shall have been amended to permit such modification or alteration.

3. All outdoor lighting shall be so shaded and adjusted that the light therefrom is directed to fall only on the same premises where such light sources are located.

4. Substantial construction of the project shall have commenced and shall be proceeding within 18 months from the effective date of this conditional use permit or any extension of time as may be granted herein by The City of San Diego pursuant to the terms set forth in Section 101.0507 and Section 101.0508 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

5. Construction and operation of the approved use shall comply at all times with the regulations of this or other governmental agencies.

6. The effectiveness of this conditional use permit is expressly conditioned upon, and the same shall not become effective for any purpose unless and until the following events shall have occurred:

a. Permittee shall have agreed to each and every condition hereof by having this conditional use permit signed within 90 days of the Council's decision. In no event shall this condition be construed to extend the time limitation set forth in 4 above; i.e., the time commences to run on the date that the City Council granted this conditional use permit.

b. This conditional use permit executed as indicated shall have been recorded in the office of the County Recorder.

7. After the establishment of the project as provided herein, the subject property shall not be used for any other purposes unless specifically authorized by the Planning Commission, or

City Council, or both unless the proposed use meets every requirement of zone existing for the subject property at the time of conversion.

8. The property included within this conditional use permit shall be used only for the purposes and under the terms and conditions as set forth in this permit unless the permit shall have been revoked by The City of San Diego.

9. In addition to any other remedy provided by law, any breach in any of the terms or conditions of this permit or any default on the part of Permittee or its successors in interest, shall be deemed a material breach hereof and this conditional use permit may be cancelled or revoked. Cancellation or revocation of this conditional use permit may be instituted by City or Permittee. The Planning Director shall set this matter for public hearing before the Planning Commission giving the same notice as provided in Section 101.0506. An appeal from the decision of the Planning Commission may be taken to the City Council within ten days after the decision is filed with the City Clerk. The Clerk shall set the matter for public hearing before the City Council giving the same notice as provided in Section 101.0506.

10. This conditional use permit shall inure to the benefit of and shall constitute a covenant running with the lands, and the terms, conditions and provisions hereof shall be binding upon Permittee, and any successor or successors thereto, and the interests of any successor shall be subject to each and every condition herein set out.
