RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ANNEX TO THE SAN DIEGO OPEN SPACE PARK FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1 ALL OF THOSE PROPERTIES ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO SUBSEQUENT TO THE FORMATION OF THE DISTRICT ON MARCH 20, 1978.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1 was established by Council Resolution No. 220486 on March 20, 1978; and

WHEREAS, said District by the terms of the resolution included all of the property within the boundaries of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to March 20, 1978, certain additional properties have been annexed to the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and desirable that said additional properties be annexed to the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1; and

WHEREAS, Section 61.2070 of the Municipal Code of the City of San Diego provides for the annexation of property to a park facilities district; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby expresses its intention to hold a hearing on the question of whether or not to annex the following described properties which have been annexed to the City of San Diego subsequent to the formation of the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1:

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1. Ferrari, et al annexation - consisting of approximately 10.39 acres as more specifically described in Council Resolution No. 220579, adopted by the City Council on April 3, 1978.

2. San Diego Pipeline reorganization annexation, as more particularly described in San Diego County Board of Supervisors Resolution, Minute Order No. 28, adopted November 7, 1978.

3. Alta Vista Island annexation - consisting of approximately 45 acres, as more particularly described in County Board of Supervisors Minute Order No. 41, adopted December 13, 1978.

4. Meanly/Floe annexation - consisting of approximately 4.64 acres, as more particularly described in City Council Resolution No. 223145, adopted March 27, 1979.

5. Fenton Materials annexation - consisting of approximately 18.88 acres, as more particularly described in City Council Resolution No. 223950, adopted July 9, 1979.

6. Kaiser-Mission Gorge annexation - consisting of approximately 102 acres, as more particularly described in City Council Resolution No. 251937, dated June 2, 1980.

Said resolutions of the City Council and the Board of Supervisors, which more particularly describe and delineate the territory proposed for annexation, are on file in the office of the City Clerk for examination by the public.


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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a hearing will be held on September 30, 1980, at which time the City Council will consider whether or not to annex said properties into the San Diego Open Space Park Facilities District No. 1.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the owners of said properties or any portion thereof may appear at the hearing and be heard, orally or by writing signed by them, and may present evidence in support or in opposition to the proposed annexation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council is hereby directed to post a copy of this resolution on the bulletin board of the City Administration Building and to cause a copy of this resolution to be published in the Daily Transcript once a week for two weeks prior to the hearing, the posting and first publication to be on or before the tenth day prior to the day of the hearing.
