

RESOLUTION NO. R - 252636

WHEREAS, the purpose of the California Conservation Corps is to further the development and maintenance of regional natural resources and the environment while providing meaningful educational work opportunities for young men and women to accomplish useful and needed public service conservation projects; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has many park development projects, including the Mission Trails Regional Park, which may ultimately contain as many as 6700 acres, which projects would be amenable to contributions in the areas of park development, watershed maintenance, fire hazard reduction, construction of bicycle trails, storm drains and erosion control provided by the young men and women of a California Conservation Corps Urban Center located in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the City would seek to assist a California Conservation Corps Urban Center in providing corpsmembers with educational opportunities which would offer them greater understanding of conservation and the natural environment and would maintain such park projects upon completion; and

WHEREAS, the existing California Conservation Corps Center in North San Diego County does not provide opportunities for corpsmembers to participate in the many projects which would be available in the Greater San Diego metropolitan area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the Governor of the State of California is urged to approve the location of a proposed California Conservation Corps Urban Center in San Diego, California, in order to more actively address the development and protection of natural resources in the region through the programs conducted by the California Conservation Corps.
