

WHEREAS, the City Manager has proposed a plan of development of certain pueblo lands to finance the decentralization of the Police Department, as more particularly described in Manager's Report No. 80-436 dated August 7, 1980; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations considered the proposal at its August 11, 1980 meeting and heard public testimony thereon; and

WHEREAS, Mac Strobl, on behalf of the Economic Development Corporation, urged the acceptance of the proposal with inclusion of the 30-acre portion of Parcel A within the Miramar Accident Potential Zone B in the planning for the development; and

WHEREAS, the Rules, Legislation and Intergovernmental Relations Committee approved the Manager's proposal with the inclusion of the 30-acre portion of Parcel A; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Manager's proposal for the development of certain pueblo lands for financing the decentralization of the Police Department with the inclusion of the 30-acre portion of Parcel A in planning for the development, as more particularly otherwise set forth in Manager's Report No. 80-436 dated August 4, 1980, be and the same is hereby approved.


2. The City Manager is further authorized to take all steps necessary to secure the services of an engineering consultant to prepare the planning, environmental and engineering
