

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the City Council of The City of San Diego requests that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District give all reasonable consideration to any proposal for commercial rehabilitation of the San Diego Rowing Club, a National Registry Historic site; the City Council believes that commercial rehabilitation may be possible without the expenditure of public funds and would result in additional revenues and historic benefits to both the Unified Port District and the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council encourages the Unified Port District to actively solicit proposals that will preserve the historic San Diego Rowing Club building prior to making any final decision regarding possible demolition.
