

RESOLUTION NO. A-252720

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Robert G. Wielage	Water Utilities	\$25	Mr. Wielage is a Waste Water Plant Lead Operator in the Quality Division. He suggested that a removeable plate be installed on the submerged effluent weirs so an inflatable bag may be placed in the unit to make a water tight seal when the sedimentation tank is out of service. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Harold F. Keezer	Fire	\$20	Mr. Keezer is a Fire Engineer. He suggested that commercial dumpsters be provided for the Fire Repair Facility. This was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Yvonne C. Paczulla	Water Utilities	\$20	Ms. Paczulla is an Intermediate Typist in the Services Division. She suggested that the intersection of 33rd Street and Boudary Street/North Park Way be simplified. This resulted in improved pavement markings and was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Charles L. Williams	General Services	\$20	Mr. Williams is a Sanitation Driver II in the Solid Waste Division. He suggested that Solid Waste employees engage in warm-up exercises to reduce the likelihood of injuries. This was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Inge Davidson	Risk Management	\$20	Ms. Davidson is a Claims Representative II in the Workers' Compensation Section. She suggested that the Workers' Compensation Section be notified that any employee with a pre-existing condition has been hired. This will be done by Claims Representatives checking with the Personnel Department when an injury occurs. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
