A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE REGIONAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING BOARD AND ENDORSING REORGANIZATION ALTERNATIVE, OPTION II(B) SET FORTH IN THE REGIONAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING BOARD AND COUNTY JUSTICE SYSTEM ADVISORY GROUP POSITION PAPER ON REORGANIZATION, 1980.

WHEREAS, the Regional Criminal Justice Planning Board (herein called "Board") has, for the past decade, served as the conduit for Law Enforcement Assistance Administration funds awarded to the San Diego region; and

WHEREAS, Congress now appears to be on the verge of drastically reducing funding; and

WHEREAS, as a result of that possibility, the need for continuing the Board is now subject to reexamination; and

WHEREAS, during recent planning and priority-setting activities, the Board and the County Justice System Advisory Group (herein called "Group") agreed that system fragmentation in the criminal justice system poses the major obstacle to efficient policy making, planning and resource allocation; and

WHEREAS, besides Board and Group, there are numerous specialized planning and advisory boards and committees; and

WHEREAS, a principal factor for the fragmentation and uncoordinated planning efforts recited above as a major problem is the absence of a single region-wide planning body; and

WHEREAS, the development of such single, region-wide planning body, possibly different from those in existence, has been proposed by a Joint Committee on Reorganization, composed

of members of Board and Group, as a possible solution to the fragmentation problems; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Committee on Reorganization has promulgated a Position Paper on Reorganization, setting forth therein recommendations for alternative solutions to the problem as perceived; and

WHEREAS, the interests of The City of San Diego in appropriately resolving this problem is of great importance to all citizens of this City and it is therefore necessary for the City Council to voice support for the best solution available; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby register and record its support for the Regional Criminal Justice Planning Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, in pursuance of continuing support for the Regional Criminal Justice Planning Board expressed above, The City of San Diego does hereby endorse the reorganization alternative, Option II(B), as more specifically described in the Regional Criminal Justice Planning Board and County Justice System Advisory Group Position Paper on Reorganization, 1980, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 252808
