BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a portion of Alcona Street, as more particularly shown on Drawing No. 14777-B on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-252399, which said Drawing is attached hereto and made a part hereof, be, and the same is hereby ordered vacated.




