RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, ABANDONING CERTAIN PROCEEDINGS PREVIOUSLY COMMENCED PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 1913 AND CERTAIN PROCEEDINGS FOR THE FORMATION OF AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT UNDERTAKEN IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECOMMENCING SUCH PROCEEDINGS AT A LATER TIME.

(Camino del Rio South, Texas Street to I-805, Assessment District)

WHEREAS, on April 28, 1980, this Council adopted
Resolution No. R-251692, declaring its intention to order
certain improvements within The City of San Diego pursuant to
the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 (commencing with Section
10000, Streets and Highways Code), describing the district to
be benefited by the improvements and to be assessed to pay the
cost and expense thereof, and making certain other determinations
and provisions in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the proceedings commenced pursuant to the Resolution of Intention, this Council adopted Resolution No. R-251695, calling a public hearing to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the formation of an underground utility district pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, certain events involving the timing of solicitation for bond bids and the maximum rate of interest which such bonds may bear make it desirable and in the best interests of the public to abandon the proceedings hereinabove described and to recommence such proceedings at a later time; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The proceedings commenced by the Resolution of Intention, Resolution No. R-251692, and by Resolution No. R-251695, be and they hereby are abandoned. Such proceedings, if recommenced, shall be undertaken anew in compliance with all provisions of law then applicable.
- 2. The City Clerk is directed to record a certified copy of this resolution in the Official Records of the Recorder of the County of San Diego, California, in compliance with the provisions of Section 3117 of the Streets and Highways Code. The certificate of the City Clerk attached to this resolution shall include a reference to the date of this resolution, the date of the Resolution of Intention, Resolution No. R-251692, the date of Resolution No. R-251695, and the date the map of the assessment district described in the Resolution of Intention was filed in the Official Records of the Recorder of the County of San Diego, California.
