

RESOLUTION NO. R-252993Adopted on OCT 2, 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Eldon D. Smith	Police	\$ 385	Mr. Smith is a Sergeant. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$380 for his suggestion to discontinue sending out correction notices on minor write-up errors on citations. One year's experience has shown a total first year's savings of \$7,630. This is the remainder of his award.
Eldon D. Smith	Police	\$ 265	Mr. Smith is a Sergeant. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$260 for his suggestion to streamline the method of processing traffic citation subpoenas. One year's experience has shown a total first year's savings of \$5,252. This is the remainder of his award.
Michael J. Berneathy	Purchasing	\$ 240	Mr. Berneathy is a Bindery Worker II in the Print Shop. He suggested that Manager's Reports not require preprinted letterhead. The estimated first year's savings as a result of this suggestion are \$1,604. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Gregorio A. Martinez	Water Utilities	\$ 215	Mr. Martinez is a Plant Operator Trainee in the Quality Division. He suggested that gloves be cleaned rather than thrown out when they become soiled. This is expected to save \$1,445 annually. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Richard L. Hoot Charles Riggs	Police	\$ 185	Mr. Hoot is a Detective, and Mr. Riggs is a Sergeant. One year ago they earned a partial award of \$180 with their suggestion to stop sending victim notification cards to low loss burglary victims. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$3,667. This is the remainder of their award.
