

RESOLUTION NO. R-252932Adopted on OCT 28 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Peggy L. Mears	Police	\$ 115	Ms. Mears is an Intermediate Typist. One year ago she earned a \$115 partial award for her suggestion to use index cards for indexing the aliases of criminal offenders. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$2,290. This is the remainder of her award.
Beatrice Hawley	Police	\$ 110	Ms. Hawley is an Intermediate Typist. One year ago she earned a partial award of \$115 for her suggestion to combine the third and fourth copies of the citation form. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$2,256. This is the remainder of her award.
George R. Ikeda	General Services	\$ 100	Mr. Ikeda is a Carpenter in the Buildings Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$100 for his suggestion to use particle board in the manufacture of cabinets. The first year's actual savings of this suggestion were \$1,975. This is the remainder of his award.
Bill Pontsler George M. Harkleroad	General Services	\$ 100	Mr. Pontsler is an Electrician Supervisor, and Mr. Harkleroad is an Electrician in the Buildings Division. They suggested that plastic coated conduit, boxes and fittings be used in areas where corrosion is likely. Estimated annual savings are \$6,696. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Douglas J. Eno	Park and Recreation	\$ 100	Mr. Eno is a Gardener in the Central Division. He suggested that additional warning signs be installed on the turnoff curve from Ingraham Street to Sunset Cliffs Road. Although savings could not be calculated, this suggestion was considered to be a significant public service improvement.
