A RESOLUTION DETERMINING AND DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST, CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUIRE THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A STORM DRAIN OR DRAINS AND APPURTENANCES THERETO IN A PORTION OF LOT 43, SIERRA VISTA, ACCORDING TO MAP THEREOF NO. 1295, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA; AND THAT THE PUBLIC-INTEREST, CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION OF AN EASEMENT IN SAID PROPERTY FOR SAID DRAIN OR DRAINS AND APPURTENANCES THERETO; AND DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO ACQUIRE SAID EASEMENT UNDER EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS: AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO COMMENCE AN ACTION IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDEMNING AND ACQUIRING SAID EASEMENT.

THERIAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has provided notice to those persons designated in Section 1245.235, Code of Civil Procedure and also has provided all persons a reasonable opportunity to appear and be heard on the matters referred to in Section 1240.030, Code of Civil Procedure; NOW, THEREPORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the public interest, convenience and necessity of The City of San Diego, and the inhabitants thereof, require the construction, operation and maintenance of a storm drain or drains and appurtenances thereto in a portion of Lot 43, Sierra Vista, according to Map thereof Mo. 1295, filed in the office of the Recorder of San Diego County, October 10, 1910, as more particularly described hereinafter.

Section 2. That the public interest, convenience and necessity of said City, and the inhabitants thereof, demand the acquisition and taking of an easement in said property for the construction, operation and maintenance of a storm drain or drains and appurtenances thereto, said real property lying within the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.

Section 3. That Section 220, the Charter of The City of San Diego; Sections 1240.010, 1240.110; 1240.120; 1255.410; Code of Civil Procedure; Sections 5101(d), 5102, Streets and Highways Code; 37350.5, 38900, 39040 and 40404, Government Code permit the acquisitions referenced herein.

Section 4. That the real property sought to be condemned is described as follows:

An easement and right-of-way for the construction, operation and maintenance of a storm drain or drains and appurtenances thereto, through, over, under, along and across the following-described property:

The Southerly ten (10) feet of Lot 43, Sierra Vista (formerly Tract No. 4 of Pacific Building Company), according to Map thereof No. 1295, filed in the office of the Recorder of San Diego County, October 10, 1910.

Section 5. That the taking and acquiring by said City of the easement hereinabove described is deemed necessary for the construction, operation and maintenance of a storm drain or drains and appurtenances thereto by The City of San Diego and the inhabitants thereof, for municipal purposes; that such use

is a public use authorized by law (Section 220, Charter of The City of San Diego; Sections 1240.010, 1240.110, 1240.120, 1255.410, Code of Civil Procedure; Sections 5101(d), 5102, Streets and Highways Code; 37350.5, 38900, 39040 and 40404, Government Code); that for such public use it is necessary that The City of San Diego condemn and acquire said easement; that said easement is to be used for the construction, operation and maintenance of a storm drain or drains and appurtenances thereto, which are planned and located in a manner most compatible with the greatest public good and the lease private injury.

Section 6. That the City Attorney of The City of San Diego be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to commence an action in the Superior Court of the State of California, in and for the County of San Diego, in the name and on behalf of the City of San Diego, against all owners and claimants to an interest in the above-described real property, for the purpose of condemning and acquiring the easement as above-described, for the use of said City.
