

RESOLUTION NO. R-253186Adopted on NOV 25 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Robert C. Frajman	General Services	\$ 75	Mr. Frajman is an Electrician in the Buildings Division. He suggested that a trap door be installed in the roof of the Brown Field water pump station to hoist out motors and pumps needing repair. This saves an estimated \$257 annually in the time it takes to remove and reinstall equipment.
Eustis Nikas Robert Snowden	General Services	\$ 65	Mr. Nikas and Mr. Snowden are Sanitation Supervisor in the Solid Waste Division. They suggested the use of rigid plastic liners in litter containers to replace corrugated liners. This is expected to save the City \$647 annually in replacement costs.
Jeffrey A. Hinck	Park and Recreation	\$ 55	Mr. Hinck is a Lifeguard in the Coastal Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$80 for his suggestion to use a different kind of descent control device. One year's experience has shown a total savings of \$1,155. This is the remainder of Mr. Hinck's award.
Vincent DeLeva	General Services	\$ 50	Mr. DeLeva was an Electrician in the Communications and Electrical Division at the time of his suggestion. He suggested that a communication program be used to warn residents of shallow electrical lines. Savings could not be calculated, but his suggestion was considered to be a significant public safety improvement.
Billy E. Davis	Fire	\$ 50	Mr. Davis is a Fire Engineer. He suggested that Onan 6000 generators be modified to prevent linkage roll pin failures. Savings could not be calculated, but this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
