

RESOLUTION NO. R-253265Adopted on DEC 15 1980

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Richard J. Hunt	Water Utilities	\$ 295	Mr. Hunt works in the Water Utilities as a Principal Engineering Aide. He suggested that Water Utilities plan checkers verify Fire Service requirements have been paid for prior to building plans being approved by the Fire Department. This is expected to generate an additional \$979 in revenue to the City.
Caroline Steyers	Building Inspection	\$ 230	Ms. Steyers is a Building Technician II in the Building Inspection Department. She suggested several revisions to the Building Permit Application (Form IR-258). These changes are expected to save the City \$2,002 annually in material and labor costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12 month review.
Mary H. Middendorf	Water Utilities	\$ 190	Ms. Middendorf is an Assistant Chemist in Water Quality. She suggested the use of a programmable calculator to prepare reports, calculate calibration curves and determine sample concentrations during analysis. This is expected to save \$1,291 a year in labor. This is a partial award pending a final 12 month review.
Herman A. Clark	Paratransit	\$ 150	Mr. Clark is a Mini-bus Driver. He suggested installing a mirror so Dial-A-Ride drivers can check head lights, brake lights, and turn signals, unassisted. This is expected to save \$993 annually in labor costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12 month review.
Charles E. Kinne	Fire	\$ 75	Mr. Kinne was a Fire Engineer in the Fire Department. He suggested a simplified method of clearing an air lock in fire apparatus. Although savings could not be calculated, this suggestion was considered to improve the performance of City equipment.
