WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego, believing it to be in the best interests of the City and of the Navy, has offered the Helix Heights site to the Navy for hospital purposes, and has offered to expeditiously assist the Navy to acquire additional adjacent land for future expansion, none of which would encroach into a dedicated park; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of the Navy recently announced his decision to build the hospital in Florida Canyon in spite of the substantial advantages of constructing the facility at Helix Heights; and

WHEREAS, the decision to build the hospital in Florida

Canyon will result in delaying the completion of the hospital

as much as eighteen months and costing an additional \$15 million

or more; and

WHEREAS, construction of the Naval Regional Medical Facility at Helix Heights would substantially enhance efforts by The City of San Diego, currently in progress, to stimulate needed economic development in Southeast San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of The City of San Diego hereby urges the President of the United States and the United States Congress to reverse the decision of the Secretary of the Navy.
