AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII, ARTICLE 5
DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTIONS 75.0103 and 75.0118,
RELATING TO APPLICATION OR TRANSFER AND PUBLIC
LIABILITY TO OPERATE A PARATRANSIT VEHICLE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VII, Article 5, Division 1 of
the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by
amending Sections 75.0103 and 75.0118 to read as follows:

SEC. 75.0103 APPLICATION OR TRANSFER

(a) All persons applying to the City Manager for
a permit or for the transfer of a permit for the opera-
tion of one or more paratransit vehicles shall file with
the City Manager, or his designated representative, a
sworn application therefor on forms provided by the City
Manager, or his designated representative, stating as
follows:

[There is no amendment to the remainder of
this section.]

SEC. 75.0118 PUBLIC LIABILITY


It shall be unlawful to operate a paratransit
vehicle unless there shall be filed with the City of
San Diego, a policy of insurance executed and delivered
by a company authorized to carry on an insurance busi-
ness in the State of California, the financial responsi-
bility of which company shall theretofore have been

approved by the City Manager, by the terms of which said insurance company assumes responsibility for injuries to persons or property caused by the operation of said vehicle in an amount determined by the City Manager and filed with the City Manager or his designated representative. A permit holder may obtain a certificate of self-insurance for a specified amount approved by Council pursuant to the applicable provisions of the California Vehicle Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

It shall be unlawful to operate a paratransit vehicle unless there shall be filed with the City of San Diego, a policy of insurance executed and delivered by a company authorized to carry on an insurance business in the State of California, the financial responsibility of which company shall theretofore have been approved by the City Manager, by the terms of which said insurance company assumes responsibility for injuries to persons or property caused by the operation of said vehicle in an amount determined by the City Manager and filed with the City ~~Clerk~~ Manager or his designated representative. A permit holder may obtain a certificate of self-insurance for a specified amount approved by Council pursuant to the applicable provisions of the California Vehicle Code.
