WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department Laboratory presently staffed with seven (7) Criminalist positions is unable to provide an acceptable level of service for both the Department and prosecuting agencies such as the District Attorney's office; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Police Department be authorized to hire two Criminalists for a period of six (6) months (December 1, 1980 through June 30, 1981); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 15298 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980-81 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Document

No. 00-15298-1, as adopted and amended therein, by adding two Criminalist positions to the Police Department staff from December 1, 1980 through June 30, 1981.

Section 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the sum of \$14,700 within the Police Department Budget from Non-Personnel to Personnel Expense and \$17,097 from the General Fund Unallocated Reserve to Police Department Budget.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
