AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15298 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980-81 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AMENDING DOCUMENT NO. 00-15298-1, AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED THEREIN, BY ADDING TO THE PERSONNEL AUTHORIZATION OF THE CITY ATTORNEY'S DEPARTMENT (045) ONE (1) LEGAL ASSISTANT TO THE LITIGATION PROGRAM (04540) TO SERVE AS A LITIGATION PARALEGAL; AND TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF \$7,625 WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND 100 FROM THE ALLOCATED RESERVE (605) TO THE CITY ATTORNEY'S DEPARTMENT (04540) FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OVERHEAD FOR THE ABOVE POSITION FOR THE PERIOD FEBRUARY THROUGH JUNE, 1981.

WHEREAS, the Legal Assistant is responsible for assisting attorneys in many phases of the practice of law as a paralegal subprofessional; and

WHEREAS, the demands of litigation have increased tremendously over the past several years and are continuing to increase at a greater rate; and

WHEREAS, to accommodate the work load, it has been determined that a Legal Assistant could assume and perform many subprofessional legal duties, thereby providing for more effective use of attorney's time; and

WHEREAS, the Legal Assistant will perform many pretrial functions now accomplished by attorneys and, in addition, provide assistance during trial; and

WHEREAS, the addition and use of a Legal Assistant will, at this point, alleviate the need for an additional attorney brought on by the influx of condemnation-associated cases in the Tijuana Valley area; and

WHEREAS, those additional lawsuits represent the start of a much greater litigation workload than has heretofore been experienced by The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, this request for a Legal Assistant is for the second half of fiscal year 1981, during which time an analysis can be conducted on the feasibility of continuing at this requested level such staff assistance for future years; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 15298 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980-81 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Document No. 00-15298-1, as adopted and amended therein, by adding to the personnel authorization schedule of Department 045, City Attorney's Department, one (1) Legal Assistant for assignment to Litigation Program (04540).

Section 2. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of \$7,625 within the General Fund 100 from the Unallocated Reserve (605) to

the City Attorney's Department (045) to be used solely and exclusively for Personal Services and related administrative overhead expenses for the above position for the period February through June, 1981.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage after two (2) public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 16, 17 and 71 of the Charter of The City of San Diego.
