AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 10 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, BY AMENDING SECTION 23.1001 (RULE IX, SECTION 1, FEB 17 1981, OF THE RULES OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION), RELATING TO TRANSFERS.

WHEREAS, under the current rules of the Civil Service

Commission, an employee must submit a formal request to transfer

from one division to another within the same department; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 1980, the Civil Service Commission, at their regularly monthly meeting, reviewed this policy; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission found that the necessity for regulating such intradepartmental transfers no longer exists and the deletion of such requirement will reduce the paper work and time currently required to make necessary staffing changes; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary and desirable to amend the San Diego Municipal Code to implement this change in policy; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 3, Division 10, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 23.1001 (Rule IX, Section 1, of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission), to read as follows:

SEC. 23.1001 TRANSFERS

All requests for transfer with reasons stated must be made in writing and subject to the approval of the Personnel Director. Transfers may be made upon the request of the

employee or upon the request of the appointing authority who must give at least a week's notice to the employee concerned.

- INTERDEPARTMENTAL TRANSFERS: The transfer of an employee from a position in one department to a position in the same class in another department shall be called an "Interdepartmental Transfer," and may be made upon written request of the appointing authorities concerned or by an employee with the approval of said appointing authorities; provided, however, that whenever the Personnel Director shall certify that a permanent employee must be transferred from one department to another as a result of an officially approved layoff under the provisions of Rule V, the appointing authority who has a vacancy in said employee's class or subdivision thereof, shall appoint said employee to said vacancy. In any event, if, at any time within 60 days from the time of transfer, the services rendered by the employee in the position to which he/she has been transferred are not satisfactory, the employee shall be transferred back to the former department.
