AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 2 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 101.0211 RELATING TO THE PROCEDURE FOR DETERMINING RESIDENTIAL DWELLING UNIT DENSITY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 2 of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and it is hereby amended by adding Section 101.0211 to read as follows:

101.0211 PROCEDURE FOR DETERMINING RESIDENTIAL DWELLING UNIT DENSITY

The number of dwelling units permitted on any lot in a zone which allows multi-family development shall be determined by dividing the area of the lot by the number of square feet required for each dwelling unit as prescribed by the zone in which the lot is located. If the quotient exceeds a whole number by .50 or more, the number of dwelling units may be increased to the next larger whole number.

EXCEPTION: In the R-2 Zone, rounding shall not apply to lots less than 6,000 square feet in area.

The number of dwelling units permitted on any lot which is located in more than one zone shall be the total of the number of units permitted in each of the zones based on the area of the lot in each zone. The dwelling units may be located on the lot without regard to the zone applicable to the particular area on which the dwelling units are located; provided, however, that the number of dwelling units within a zoned area may not exceed the density permitted in the next less restrictive zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

EXCEPTION: In the P-2 zone, rounding shall not apply to fots less than 6,000 square feet in area.

The number of dwelling units permitted on any lot which is located in more than one zone shall be the total of the flumber of units permitted in each of the zones based on the lot units permitted in each of the zone applicable to the porticular area on which the dwelling units are located provided; however, that the number of dwelling units are located provided; however, that the number of dwelling units within a zoned area may not exceed the density permitted in the half less restrictive zone.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the introduced on March 9, 1981.
