(a) All areas within the corporate limits of the City of San Diego lying northerly of the center line of the San Diego River Channel, as said line was established by the City Council in Document No. 750693 on file in the office of the City Clerk which is by this reference incorporated into this ordinance as if set out fully herein; provided, however, that those areas more particularly delineated in Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 8926 (N.S.) on file in the office of the City Clerk which is by this reference hereby incorporated into this ordinance as if set out fully herein, are hereby excluded from the service area granted from this franchise ordinance.

Said exhibit to contain a map and legal description of said additional areas;

(b) Provided, however, that in no event shall the foregoing service area descriptions exclude from this franchise ordinance any area now served by Grantee and inadvertently omitted due to inaccuracies or oversight in said service area description.

Section 2. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 15213 remain in full force and effect.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force Section 3. on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
