AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING CERTAIN LANDS IN  
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND  
NAMING SAID PARK "CREST CANYON NEIGHBORHOOD PARK."

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That portions of Del Mar Heights and vacated portions of Caseta Drive and El Amigo Road, as more particularly described in Exhibit A hereto which is by this reference incorporated herein, are hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby named CREST CANYON NEIGHBORHOOD PARK.

Section 3. That the City Clerk of said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file for record in the office of the San Diego County Recorder a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION  
CREST CANYON NEIGHBORHOOD PARK

Lots 1 and 2 in Block 11; Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and that portion of Lot 7 in Block 16; and that portion of that certain parcel of land delineated and designated as "Reservoir," all in Del Mar Heights, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Map thereof No. 157 filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, July 8, 1887, together with vacated portions of Caseta Drive and El Amigo Road, all being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centerline of Durango Drive with the northerly boundary of Del Mar Heights Road, as said streets are located and established as of the date of this instrument, said point of intersection being a point in the arc of a 949.00 foot radius curve, concave northeasterly, a radial to said point bears  $S12^{\circ}53'50''W$ ; thence northwesterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of  $02^{\circ}28'16''$ , a distance of 40.93 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, a radial to said point bears  $S15^{\circ}22'06''W$ ; thence continuing along the arc of the above-described curve, being along the northerly boundary of said Del Mar Heights Road, through a central angle of  $06^{\circ}09'06''$ , a distance of 101.89 feet; thence along said northerly street boundary  $N68^{\circ}28'48''W$ , 413.87 feet to a point of intersection with the easterly boundary of Crest Way, as said street is located and established as of the date of this instrument, said point of intersection being a point in the arc of a 850.00 foot radius curve, concave southwesterly, a radial to said point bears  $N75^{\circ}42'25''E$ ; thence northwesterly along the arc of said curve, being along the easterly boundary of said Crest Way, through a central angle of  $04^{\circ}21'55''$ , a distance of 64.76 feet; thence along said easterly street boundary  $N18^{\circ}40'00''W$ , 311.00 feet; thence  $N40^{\circ}08'40''E$ , 630.39 feet; thence  $S89^{\circ}14'25''E$ , 206.65 feet to a point in the westerly boundary of said Durango Drive; thence along said westerly boundary of Durango Drive  $S00^{\circ}45'35''W$ , 1,020.00 feet returning to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
