AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15510 (NEW SERIES) ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1981-82," BY PLACING CERTAIN DESIGNATED POSITIONS IN THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE AND CREATING NEW CLASS TITLES AND ESTABLISHING RATES OF COMPENSATION THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, Section 117(a)17 of the Charter provides that "managerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs" may be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance upon first having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that the classes of Deputy Fire Chief, Deputy Police Chief and Police Commander meet those qualifications and definitions; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has further determined that the new classifications of Assistant to the Fire Chief and Fire Shift Commander also meet those qualifications and definitions and should also be designated as unclassified; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has reviewed this request on June 11, 1981, and commented to the Council upon the requested exemptions from the classified service of the five classes; and

WHEREAS, a review of these five classes indicates the nature and duties of these five positions are consistent with the unclassified criteria set forth in Charter Section 117(a)17; and

WHEREAS, it is now requested that those positions be exempted from the Classified Service pursuant to the Charter provisions; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the annual appropriation ordinance to effectuate said exemption; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 117(a)17 of the City Charter, after having been reviewed and commented upon by the Civil Service Commission on June 11, 1981, the following positions are hereby exempted from the Classified Service and declared to be in the Unclassified Service of The City of San Diego:

Deputy Fire Chief

Deputy Police Chief

Police Commander

and that Ordinance No. 15510 (New Series) entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1981-82," be so amended to amend Exhibit C thereto as to reflect said position designations in the Unclassified Service.


Section 2. That Ordinance No. 15510 (New Series) entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1981-82," be and the same is hereby further amended by amending Exhibit C thereto to create and establish the unclassified positions of Assistant to the Fire Chief and Fire Shift Commander.

Section 3. As a schedule of compensation for the positions enumerated and created in Sections 1 and 2 above, the positions are hereby authorized and designated to be placed in Managerial Classification Range of Managerial C with Salary Ranges of 7.7 and 7.8.

Section 4. That the City Manager and City Attorney be and they are hereby authorized and directed to reflect the above amendments in the personnel authorization schedules for the departments affected when preparing the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for Fiscal Year 1981-82.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
