

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 15581 (New Series)

Adopted on SEP 14 1981

An Ordinance Incorporating Lots G through L, Block 353, Horton's Addition Lockling and a Portion of Redwood Street Closed (Approximately 34,000 sq. ft.). Located on the West Side of Fourth Avenue Between Spruce and Quince Streets, in the Uptown Community Plan Area, in the City of San Diego, California, into R-1-40 and R-3A Zones, as Defined by Sections 101.0407 and 101.0412, Respectively, of the San Diego Municipal Code, and Repealing Ordinance No. 12987, Approved October 20, 1930, of the Ordinances of The City of San Diego Insofar as the Same Conflicts Herewith.


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Lots G through L, Block 353, Horton's Addition Lockling and a portion of Redwood Street closed (approximately 34,000 sq. ft.), located on the west side of Fourth Avenue between Spruce and Quince Streets, in the Uptown Community Plan Area, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundary of the district designated "R-1-40" and "R-3A" on Zone Map Drawing No. B-3425.2, be, and it is hereby incorporated into R-1-40 and R-3A Zones, as such zones are described and defined by Sections 101.0427 and 101.0412, respectively, of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. O-12987, approved October 20, 1930, of the ordinances of The City of San Diego be, and it is hereby repealed insofar as it conflicts herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
