AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 7, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 27.2941(b), RELATING TO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 7, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by amending Section 27.2941(b) to read as follows:

SEC. 27.2941 CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS--LIMITATIONS

(a) No change.

(b) No person shall make, and no campaign treasurer shall solicit or accept, any contribution which will cause the total amount contributed by such person with respect to a single election in support of or opposition to a measure to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500). Provided, however, the campaign for or against the qualification of a measure shall be considered separate and distinct from the campaign in support of or in opposition to the measure once qualified, and a person may contribute up to \$500 to each campaign.

(c), (d) and (e) No change.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
