Section 1. That portions of Normal Heights, Rancho Mission, Kensington

Manor Unit No. 2, Kensignton Heights Extension Unit No. 2 and the Resubdivision

of Block 10 of Kensington Park, which is more particularly described in Exhibit

A hereto which is by this reference incorporated herein, is hereby set aside

and dedicated in perpetuity for open space and park purposes.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file for record in the office of the San Diego County Recorder a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

KENSINGTON OPEN SPACE PARK RESERVE

Parcel 1
