AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 4, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 24.0404, RELATING TO ANNUAL SUPLEMENTAL BENEFITS - QUALIFICATIONS AND DETERMINATION.

WHEREAS, the Council in 1980, established an Annual Supplemental Benefits

Program whereby one-half of the excess earnings of the Retirement System are
shared with Qualified Retirees: and

WHEREAS, within the previously excluded class of Special Safety Members, there exists Fifty-Nine (59) retirees receiving fixed benefits; and WHEREAS, the current members of the System, by secret ballot, elected to include those retirees in the Annual Supplemental Benefits Program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 4, of the San Diego Municipal Code
be, and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 24.0404 to read as
follows:

SEC. 24.0404 ANNUAL SUPPLEMENTAL BENEFITS - QUALIFICATION AND DETERMINATION

No Change to first paragraph and subsections A.1. and 2.

- 3. Qualified Retirees shall be limited to the following classes:
 - a. Retired General and Safety members;
 - b. Retired Unified Port District members; and
 - c. Special class safety members who are receiving fixed monthly retirement benefits; and

d. Survivors of (a), (b) and (c) above receiving monthy pensions from the system, provided such member had met the minimum continuous service requirement in subsection A.1. above.

No changes in 4., B.1., 2., 3., 4., 5., 6., and C.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
