AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING SECTION 63.30 PROVIDING FOR THE UTILIZATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL GROWTH FUNDS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 63.30 to read as follows:

Pursuant to the Environmental Growth Fund provision of the Charter of The City of San Diego, Section 103.1a, it is incumbent upon the City Council of The City of San Diego to use moneys derived from that fund exclusively for the purpose of preserving and enhancing the environment of The City of San Diego. The City Council of The City of San Diego, in implementing said Charter provision, shall allocate all moneys within the fund not employed to pay the debt service on bonds, as set forth in Section 103.1a of the Charter as follows:

1. The difference between two-thirds of the Environmental Growth Fund and the amount actually necessary to make principle and interest payments on outstanding open space bonds shall be accumulated and utilized solely for the purpose

of providing funds for the acquisition of open space lands.

- 2. The remaining one-third of the Environmental Growth Fund shall be used for the purpose
 of preserving and enhancing the environment and
 shall be allocated to utilization each year, by the
 City Council, during the budget process, in
 accordance with the following priorities:
 - a. Open space maintenance, includinglitter removal and control;
 - b. To provide matching funds for acquiring open space in cooperation with other private or governmental entities;
 - c. Regional Park maintenance;
 - d. Any other purposes consistent with the City Charter Section 103.1a.
- 3. The City Manager of the City of San Diego shall prepare, for approval by the City Council, regulations for the administration of the open space matching grant program.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be and become effective on July 1, 1982.
