AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 4,
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING
SECTION 64.35 RELATING TO SEWER CAPACITY
CHARGES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 4, of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending
Section 64.35 to read as follows:

SEC. 64.35 CAPACITY CHARGE

A minimum capacity charge as established from time
to time by a resolution of the City Council shall be paid
when any person, firm, corporation or other entity shall
request a new sewer connection, an additional connection,
a larger sewer connection or in any other way cause an
increase in the flow into the sewer by the addition of
any type of dwelling, commercial or industrial unit.

Such minimum capacity charge shall be based upon an
increase in the flow of sewage as measured by equivalent
family unit or units or portion thereof as determined by
the City Manager or his authorized representative. For
the purposes of this section, an equivalent family unit
shall equal a sewage flow of 280 gallons per day.

Prior to considering any change in said sewer ser-
vice charge by resolution as aforesaid, a notice of the
proposed change shall be posted by the City Clerk at
least ten (10) days prior to consideration of such a

resolution by the City Council. This charge shall be due and payable at the time the building permit fees are paid, or if a building permit is not required, at the time the sewer connection fees must be paid. In any case, this sewer capacity charge must be paid before the sewage flow increase is accomplished.

This section shall not be construed to pertain to agreements between participating agencies in the Metropolitan Sewerage System and the City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
