AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IX, ARTICLE 7 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 97.0103 AND 97.0301, RELATING TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT REVENUE BOND LAW.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:
