

RESOLUTION NO. R-253511Adopted on JAN 27 1981

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Donald R. Jordan	Park and Recreation	\$ 410	Mr. Jordan is an Equipment Operator I in the Central Division. He suggested that equipment used to spread debris be modified to eliminate equipment breakdown. This is expected to save \$2,712 annually in labor and equipment costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Terrylynn Bolton	Risk Management	\$ 260	Ms. Bolton is an Intermediate Typist in the Public Liability program. She suggested that the procedure for notifying responsible parties in recovery actions be revised. This is expected to save \$1,748 annually in processing costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Ed Doherty Jack A. Mead	Park and Recreation	\$ 200	Mr. Doherty is an Equipment Technician I, and Mr. Mead is an Equipment Technician II in the Central Division. They suggested that tubes in the heat exchanger at Mission Beach Plunge be hydrostatically tested. This alleviated erratic exchanger operation and allowed continued operation of the pool. Hard savings can not be calculated, but this was considered to be a significant safety and operational improvement.
Gordon G. Redding	Police	\$ 200	Mr. Redding is a Sergeant. He suggested that victim notification cards not be sent to victims unless the victim lives out-of-town. This is expected to save \$4,621 annually in processing costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
