Resolution No. 253543 was assigned to Item 150c on the Docket of February 2, 1981, introducing an ordinance amending Chapter VI, Article 4 of the San Diego Municipal Code by Adding Section 64.22 relating to Restrictions on the Discharge of Residual Brine from Water Softeners into the Public Sewerage System.

However, Item 150c should have introduced the Ordinance for adoption at a later date, which did not require a Resolution number. Therefore, the number will not be used.
