## RESOLUTION NO. R-253638

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has worked with the FEB 17 1381 San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) to update the growth forecasts for the San Diego Region; and

WHEREAS, this cooperative region-wide effort was initiated in order to obtain a set of estimates to serve as a basis for regional planning; and

WHEREAS, these updated forecasts are consistent with
The City of San Diego's adopted Progress Guide and General
Plan and community plans, and will provide a basis for the
planning of future sewage collection and treatment facilities
as a component of the Areawide Water Quality Management Plan,
the updated Air Quality Maintenance Plan, and other regional
plans and studies; and

WHEREAS, local agreement on a consistent set of forecasts will minimize questions about population growth often raised by the federal and state agencies which fund waste-water treatment facilities and, hence, save time and money for local jurisdictions seeking such finding; and

WHEREAS, these forecasts will be updated every two years, or more often if directed by the SANDAG Board, to reflect changes in actual growth patterns and changes in local and regional plans and policies; and

whereas, the acceptance of these forecasts will have no effect on the state subventions received by The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the revised Series V Regional Growth Forecasts for the City and its six major statistical areas, as set forth in the attached tables, be and they are hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that these forecasts be and they are hereby authorized for use by the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) in the Areawide Water Quality Management Plan, Air Quality Maintenance Plan, Clearinghouse Review Procedures, regional transportation and housing planning, and other regional studies described in the approved SANDAG FY 1981-83 Overall Work Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City's representative to SANDAG be, and he is hereby authorized to support a corresponding amendment of the Series V Regional Growth Forecasts previously adopted by the SANDAG Board of Directors as an element of the Regional Comprehensive Plan.
