

RESOLUTION NO. R-253796

(R. 81-1598)

WHEREAS, Knotts Berry Farm of Buena Park, California, is disposing of its cable car fleet and has offered to donate one of the vehicles to San Diego for operation on the Gaslamp Quarter/Centre City Trolley Line; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle has been inspected by engineers from the San Francisco Municipal Railway and the State Public Utilities Commission who found it to be in excellent condition; and

WHEREAS, if accepted by San Diego, the vehicle would require regauging to be compatible with the existing tracks in San Diego and also require conversion from battery to trolley operation; and

WHEREAS, if accepted and approved by Council, responsibility for the cable car would be contracted to the Gaslamp Quarter Association, which would maintain the vehicle until such time as the trolley line became operational when it would be transferred to the operating agency; and

WHEREAS, in the interim, the Gaslamp Quarter Association would move the trolley to San Diego, provide a secure storage area and make improvements to the trolley so that it can be fully operational; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the offer by Knotts Berry Farm to donate one of its trolley cars as a gift to San Diego for use on the Gaslamp Quarter/Centre City Trolley Line be and it is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council, for and on behalf of itself and the people of The City of San Diego, does hereby extend to Knotts Berry Farm of Buena Park, California, a declaration of gratitude and thanks for the generous gift of the trolley car.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the letter offer of the Gaslamp Quarter Association to move the trolley car to San Diego and assume responsibility for its safe keeping and improvements until it can be placed into operational service at a cost not to exceed \$5,000 be and the same is hereby approved and accepted.
