

RESOLUTION NO. R-253820

(R. 81-1688)

WHEREAS, the California Department of Corrections and Governor Brown have expressed a desire and plans to build a "detention facility" on Otay Mesa to house a portion of the projected expanded State prisoner population; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a facility at Otay Mesa would introduce millions of dollars of construction activity to the local economy and the operation of that facility would produce an important payroll in an area that suffers from chronic high level unemployment; and

WHEREAS, the supplies and support services required by the new prison will provide millions of dollars in additional income for that area and the operation of a detention facility at Otay Mesa would be among compatible projected future Industrial/Commercial uses at the Mesa; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego reaffirms its opposition to the California Department of Corrections current site for the detention facility located at the border; and

WHEREAS, the Kuebler Ranch site continues to present an acceptable location for the proposed prison; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that said City urges Governor Brown and the State Department of Corrections to seriously consider purchasing the Kuebler Ranch site for the sole purpose of constructing and operating a detention facility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego is willing to work with the State Department of Corrections to find a site in the Otay Mesa area which is mutually acceptable to the City of San Diego and the State of California if the Kuebler Ranch site is unacceptable to the State Department of Corrections.
