## RESOLUTION NO. R 253870

WHEREAS, the Charter of The City of San Diego provides that the municipal primary election shall be held on the third Tuesday in September of each odd-numbered year, and that the general municipal election shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of the same year; and

WHEREAS, commencing with the year 1984 the elections to the offices of Mayor and City Attorney shall be held every four (4) years, and the municipal primary election for these offices shall be held on the same date in each election year as the California State primary election and the general election for these offices shall be held on the same day as the California State general election for that year; and

WHEREAS, in the year 1981, the municipal primary election will be held on the 15th day of September and will be an election in which the voters will choose candidates for nomination to Council offices in Council Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7, to Board of Education offices in School District Regions B and C, and to Community College Board of Trustee offices in College District Regions A, C and E; and

WHEREAS, all the voters in the City of San Diego would not be entitled to vote for candidates at the municipal primary election to be held on September 15, 1981; and

whereas, submittal of ballot measures to the voters on the day of the municipal primary election would require calling a special municipal election to be conducted citywide; and

WHEREAS, deferring the submittal of ballot measures to the voters by seven weeks, from September 15, 1981 until November 3, 1981, and calling just one special municipal election consolidated with the citywide general municipal election, would result in overall election economies as opposed to the calling of two special municipal elections; one in conjunction with the municipal primary and one consolidated with the general municipal election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That for purposes of application of Council Policy 000-21, the next election for which the notification and submittal of ballot proposals shall apply is the general municipal election scheduled to be held on November 3, 1981.
