## LIST OF ASSURANCES

The applicant, The City of San Diego, hereby assures and certifies that it will comply with Conservancy regulations, policies, guidelines and requirements as they relate to the acceptance and use of Conservancy funds for this project. Also, the applicant gives assurance and certifies with respect to the grant that:

- 1. It possesses legal authority to apply for the grant, and to finance and construct the proposed facilities; that, where appropriate, a resolution, motion or similar action has been duly adopted or passed as an official act of the applicant's governing body, authorizing the filing of the application, including all understandings and assurances contained therein, and directing and authorizing the person identified as the offical representative of the applicant to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.
- 2. It will have sufficient funds available to meet its own share of the cost for projects. Sufficient funds will be available when the project is completed to assure the effective operation and maintenance of the facility for the purposes constructed.
- 3. It will give the Conservancy, through any authorized representative, access to and the right to examine all records, books, papers, or documents related to the grant.
- 4. It will cause work on the project to be commenced within a reasonable time after receipt of notification from the Conservancy that funds have been approved and that the project will be prosecuted to completion with reasonable diligence.
- 5. It will not dispose of or encumber its title or other interests in the site and facilities except as permitted by the Conservancy.
- 6. It will, where appropriate, comply with the requirements of the State's Braithwaite Act (Chapter 1574, Statutes of 1971 and related statutes), which provides for fair and equitable treatment of displaced persons.
- 7. It will, where appropriate, comply with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.
- 8. It will comply with all requirements imposed by the Conservancy concerning special provisions of law, and program requirements.
