

RESOLUTION NO. R-253963

WHEREAS, the effort to enact "Urban Jobs and Enterprise Zone" legislation has been a bipartisan effort to encourage reindustrialization of blighted areas; and

WHEREAS, Congressman Jack Kemp (Rep., N.Y.) and Senator Rudy Boschwitz (Rep., MN.) are expected to introduce such legislation by the end of March, 1981; and

WHEREAS, State Senator William Campbell has introduced Senate Bill 27 which creates enterprise zones in the heart of blighted areas, where businesses and/or their employees would be given tax breaks; and

WHEREAS, this legislation is expected to provide firms incentives such as reductions in capital gains and corporate income taxes in exchange for locating in the zone and hiring at least 50% of their company's work force from the local population; and

WHEREAS, this legislation could be a useful tool to aid the City's Economic Development and Redevelopment efforts;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of said City, declares its support for Senate Bill 27, a state bill entitled "Urban Job Zones."


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City's Washington, D.C., Legislative Representative is hereby directed to actively

support the federal Urban Jobs and Enterprise Zone legislation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City's Sacramento and Washington, D.C., Legislative Representatives shall work for language which minimizes the impact of a loss of local property tax dollars if this form of incentive is offered in any legislation.
