BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the plans and specifications for the furnishing of all labor, material, tools, equipment, transportation and other expense necessary or incidental for

LA JOLLA PARK AND RECREATION CENTER - SPORTSFIELD RECONSTRUCTION, San Diego,

California

filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of San Diego, California, on APR 22 '81, and bearing official Document No. H-C0193, be, and the same are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council has ascertained the current or prevailing rate of per diem wages paid by private employers in the City for each craft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the contract, and does hereby declare that the wage scale included in said specifications is the said current or prevailing rate for the various crafts therein mentioned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing Agent of the City of San Diego be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to publish in accordance with law, notice to contractors calling for bids for the work hereinabove described, in accordance with the plans and specifications hereinabove referred to.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible and reliable bidder for

LA JOLLA PARK AND RECREATION CENTER - SPORTSFIELD RECONSTRUCTION.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the generous donation of \$22,500.00 from LAS PATRONAS ORGANIZATION for the reconstruction of the sportsfield at the La Jolla Park and Recreation Center is hereby accepted; and that the Las Patronas Organization is hereby commended for this act of civic generosity, and publicly expressing, on behalf of the Citizens of San Diego, a debt of gratitude.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to add CIP 29-477, LA JOLLA PARK AND RECREATION CENTER-SPORTSFIELD RECONSTRUCTION, into the 1981 Capital Improvement Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer the \$22,500.00 LAS PATRONAS ORGANIZATION Donation Trust Fund 63021 and an amount not to exceed \$22,500.00 from PSD Fund 17501, to CIP 29-477, LA JOLLA PARK AND RECREATION CENTER-SPORTSFIELD RECONSTRUCTION.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of \$45,000.00 from CIP 29-477, LA JOLLA PARK AND RECREATION CENTER-SPORTSFIELD RECONSTRUCTION of the City of San Diego is hereby authorized solely and exclusively for providing funds for said project and related costs, and authorizing the Auditor and Comptroller upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
