WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is aware that there is a MAY 5 1981 growing need for new prisons in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has consistently supported the building of new prisons in California; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has attempted to work with the Department of Corrections to find a mutually agreeable site in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego does believe that the decision to build a prison on the state-owned site on Otay Mesa is completely inappropriate from the point of view of international relations with Mexico and incompatible with the immediately surrounding land uses; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego continues to vigorously support the building of a prison in San Diego on Otay Mesa, but on a site other than the state-owned site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego stands ready to do everything appropriate within its power to assist the Department of Corrections in finding a mutually agreeable site for a prison in the area.
