

RESOLUTION NO. R-254223

(R. 81-2100)

MAY 18 1981

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 780 (herein AB 780) sponsored by Assemblyman Waddie Deddah, is a single purpose bill affecting only the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of AB 780 would create special disability leave provisions for police and fire personnel, patterned upon the provisions of the State Public Employees Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, such special and unique legislative action, applicable to a single city, has never before been imposed upon any other charter city; and

WHEREAS, such state legislative action affecting the compensation policies and practices of a charter city constitutes an intrusion into and upon the municipal affairs of said city; and

WHEREAS, such action in addition to violating the intent of the municipal affairs provision of the California Constitution, also intrudes upon the meet and confer process called for in the California Government Code by mandating benefits subject to meet and confer; and

WHEREAS, such results by AB 780 establishes a dangerous precedent in that it bypasses the legislative authority of the City of San Diego and frustrates the expressed will of the people; and

WHEREAS, AB 780 also creates a potentially large expense to the City without providing an offsetting appropriation to accommodate that expense, thereby creating a budgetary hardship in an age of revenue shortfalls and increased demands for service; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this City Council, acting pursuant to the legislative authority vested in it by the Charter of The City of San Diego, does hereby express its unanimous opposition to AB 780.
