RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION BY MAIL HELD ON MAY 5, 1981, ON A REFERENDUM OF THE PEOPLE OF SAN DIEGO FOR APPROVAL OR REJECTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 15375 (NEW SERIES) ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THAT CERTAIN LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO OF CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE COLUMBIA REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A CONVENTION AND EXHIBIT CENTER."

WHEREAS, this Council by Ordinance No. 15452 (New Series), adopted February 17, 1981, called a special municipal election by mail to be held in the City on May 5, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the special municipal election by mail was held on May 5, 1981, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City Ordinance No. 15375 (New Series), as follows:

PROPOSITION A:

APPROVAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 15375 (NEW SERIES).

Shall Ordinance No. 15375 (New Series) of the Ordinances of The City of San Diego adopted by the Council on October 28, 1980, which approved a lease agreement between The City of San Diego and the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego of certain property located in the Columbia Redevelopment Project for the purpose of construction and operation of a convention and exhibition center be approved?

WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego canvassing the returns of the special municipal election by mail, as certified to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of the special municipal election by mail has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

1. The total number of votes cast in the City is 261,433.
2. The number of votes cast for and against the proposition lettered A and the total number of votes cast upon the proposition are as follows:

PROPOSITION A:

For	112,848 (43.4%)
Against	<u>147,083</u> (56.6%)
Total	259,931

3. Proposition A did not receive the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters voting on said proposition and is hereby declared to have failed.

4. The number of votes cast is recorded in the Elections Returns Book, which book is a part of the records of this Council.

5. The City Clerk shall make public the results of the canvass of the special municipal election by mail by publication of a copy of this resolution.
