Exhibit A

Statement of Work

This document describes deliverable items and services to be provided by the Contractor to the City of San Diego in order to provide certain specific modifications to the current computer aided dispatch system. It is the intent here that the work outlined will provide a fully operational CAD system. All hardware and services which are necessary to complete the installation of hardware and software described in this document are included whether specifically mentioned or not, and are being supplied by the Contractor.

Software to be Provided

Software to be provided will be the MDS500 baseline software package including: (Software to be provided is further described in Exhibit B.)

- 1. Police agency dispatch functions.
- 2. Fire Agency dispatch functions.
- 3. Motorola SMT70 Status message functions.
- 4. Five inquiry functions currently in use including CLETS formats modified as described in State of California, Department of Justice notice dated January 15, 1980.
- 5. Inquiry interface to local message switch in IBM2740 protocol.
- 5. Street to beat file, compatible with direct loading of local DIME files (EBCDIC to ASCII conversion if required, is a responsibility of the City).
- 7. System Response time report.
- 8. Burglar Alarm file functions.

Installation to be Provided

Contractor will install all hardware and software in accordance with agreement terms, statement of work and Exhibit B to provide a fully operational "Turn Key" system.

All equipment will be installed in the Computer Equipment room at 1222 First Avenue, San Diego, in parallel operation to the existing system. Upon satisfactory tests and approval of these tests by the City and assurance of completeness by the contractor's program manager, Contractor will disconnect and remove all equipment not required in the new system configuration and commence installation of VDT's and printer equipment. This will result in approximately one week of down time for dispatch operations.

In order to provide the system installation in the minimum amount of time, all personnel required for any aspect of hardware or software installation shall be on site, or immediately available.
