WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

Edna Gonzales	Police	\$ 165	Ms. Gonzales is an Intermediate Typist. One year ago she earned a partial award of \$145 for her suggestion to eliminate the processing of FBI slips. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$3,097. This is the remainder of her award.
Betty A. Goldberg	City Clerk	\$ 150	Ms. Goldberg is a Senior Typist. She suggested that Notices of Public Hearing be printed on one sheet and mailed without envelopes. This is expected to save \$1,007 in time and material. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Debra J. Wake	Police	\$ 140	Ms. Wake is an Intermediate Typist. She suggested that name tags for civilian employees be ordered on an as-requested basis. This is expected to save \$986 in the first year in time and material. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Ruth T. Nelson Yolanda S. Guaderrama	Personnel	\$ 125	Ms. Nelson is an Assistant Personnel Analyst and Ms. Guaderrama is an Intermediate Clerk. One year ago they suggested that the routine checking of employment information cards for every applicant be eliminated and earned a partial award of \$55. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$1,816. This is the remainder of their award.
David R. Jacks	General Services	\$ 125	Mr. Jacks is an Equipment Mechanic Apprentice in the Equipment Division. He suggested that the backing plates on disc brakes be cut away to prevent debris from collecting in the brake housing. This is expected to save \$424 in costs for labor, equipment and material.
