

RESOLUTION NO. R-254341Adopted on JUN 2 1981

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

Rita B. Andrews	City Clerk	\$ 30	Ms. Andrews is a Senior Stenographer. She suggested that tapes be labeled differently to allow for a more efficient use of storage space. Although savings were difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Kenneth L. Leininger	Fire	\$ 25	Mr. Leininger is a Fire Engineer. He suggested that the department purchase a different brand of safety goggles. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Paul J. Bednarzyk	General Services	\$ 25	Mr. Bednarzyk is a Service Writer in the Equipment Division. He suggested that the engines on the 1977 Master packers be wired differently to prevent air throttle problems. While tests were being conducted on the suggested method, a simpler and less expensive method was found to prevent the problem. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this is considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Delorese J. Shafer	Risk Management	\$ 25	Ms. Shafer is an Intermediate Typist. One year ago she suggested that a filing system be established for long distance call slips, and earned a partial award of \$15. One year's experience has shown a saving of \$163 in the Risk Management Department, and additional unestimated savings in the City Attorney's office. This is the remainder of her award.
Sylvia L. Johnson	Financial Management	\$ 25	Ms. Johnson is a Senior Clerk. She suggested that applications for taxicab permits be received in the Paratransit Office rather than in the City Clerk's Office. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
