That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

Mary F. Labiak	Park and Pecreation	\$ 20	Ms. Labiak is an Intermediate Typist in the Central Division. She suggested that subdivision maps for condominium conversions be clearly identified to distinguish them from new subdivisions. Although savings were difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Jeffrey L. Frankhouser	General Services	\$ 20	Mr. Frankhouser is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. He suggested that the metal fuel line be positioned next to the carburetor fitting when replacing the fuel line. Although savings were difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
David P. Lee	Fire	\$ 20	Mr. Lee is a Fire Fighter. He suggested that outdated first aid kits be utilized as trauma boxes on the apparatuses. Although savings were difficult to calculate, this was considered to be a significant public safety improvement.
Clarence Haseyama	City Auditor	\$ 20	Mr. Haseyama was a Cost Clerk at the time he submitted this suggestion to improve the processing and reporting of equipment cards. Portions of his suggestion have been implemented, although savings were difficult to calculate. This was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Patricia L. Page	Water Utilities	\$ 20	Ms. Page is a Senior Clerk in the Metro Waste Water Division. She suggested that a cost center block be added to Form AC-24. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
