WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

<u>NAME</u>	<u>DEPARTMENT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>	<u>SUGGESTION</u>
Andrew M. Drop	General Services	\$ 30	Mr. Drop is an Electrician Supervisor in the Communications and Electrical Division. One year ago he earned a partial award of \$80 for his suggestion to replace the glass lenses and reflectors in traffic signals with polycarbonate lenses and metal reflectors. One year's experience has shown a savings of \$1,113. This is the remainder of his award.
Arnold H. Smith	General Services	\$ 25	Mr. Smith is an Equipment Technician II in the Equipment Division. He suggested that the plumbing fixtures in an abandoned restroom be replaced. Although savings were difficult to identify, this was considered to be a significant operational improvement.
Florencia V. Santos	Building Inspection	\$ 25	Ms. Santos is an Intermediate Typist in the Office Services Section. She suggested that a drawing illustrating the requirements for a sign permit be designed and added to the current handout. This is expected to save \$75 in the first year in labor costs and increase public service. This is a partial award pending a final 12 month review.
Robert H. Abrahamsen	Property	\$ 25	Mr. Abrahamsen is a Laborer at Mt. Hope Cemetery. He suggested that the trailer hitches on tow vehicles be modified to improve safety. Although savings were difficult to estimate, this was considered to be a significant safety improvement.
Philip Garofalo	Planning	\$ 15	Mr. Garofalo is an Associate Planner in the Current Planning Division. He suggested that Easement acquisitions and abandonments be eliminated from Planning review. This is expected to save \$54 in the first year in labor costs.
